The initiative on Regional Service Centers and Shared Services model is still on schedule. The report will be completed by the end of the calendar year and legislative action would be expected in the first 6 months of 2012., for implementation July 1, 2012.

## More OASBO History!

There's still lots to learn about OASBO's impressive 75 year history! Here are more interesting facts about annual meetings, past leaders & hot topics.

### February 24 – 26, 1965 – Plaza Hotel, Columbus, Ohio

In spite of the worst traveling conditions of the winter there were 236 persons registered. Milton Blunk was President. The most important bill passed by the 106<sup>th</sup> General Assembly was the amendment to the School Foundation Law which provided recognition to the non-teaching school employees and salary increases.

### February 2 – 4, 1966 – Sheraton Columbus Hotel, Columbus, Ohio

John Steinhauer was President. Dues were raised from \$3.00 to \$5.00. There were 252 persons present. Mr. Krabach, State Director of Finance, spoke on a solution to funding in the State of Ohio, that being the bringing of more industry into Ohio to broaden the tax base. The Professionalization Committee recommended that three distinct certificates be set as follows: 1. School Business Administrator; 2, School Business Fiscal Officer/Business Manager; 3. School Business Official. H. Dale Thomas, Margaret Casey, George Ernst, and Wesley Ridenour were issued life memberships.
